Plan 2.1 - Non-credit courses, 7 credits; Credit courses, 24 credits; Thesis, equivalent of 36 credits.

Plan 2.2 - Non-credit courses, 7 credits; Credit courses, 24 credits; Thesis, equivalent of 48 credits.

Eligibility to apply:

Plan 1.1 is for those with the following qualifications:

- (1) M.A. in Architectural Heritage Management and Tourism or Architectural Heritage, Creative Industries, and Tourism Management ***or***

- (2) Master's degree with at least 4 years working experience after graduation or have profound knowledge and extensive practical experience in a field related to the program (subject to approval by the program/admission committee).
- (3) English proficiency test results at the level according to requirement set by Silpakorn University.
- (4) Possess the qualities stipulated under Article 7 of Silpakorn University Graduate Studies Regulations, 2023 and/or subsequent changes thereof.

Plan 1.2 is for those with the following qualifications:

- (1) Bachelor's degree with minimum grade point average of 3.50 and at least 6 years working experience after graduation or have profound knowledge and extensive practical experience in a field related to the program (subject to approval by the program/admission committee).
- (2) English proficiency test results at the level according to requirement set by Silpakorn University.
- (3) Possess the qualities stipulated under Article 7 of Silpakorn University Graduate Studies Regulations, 2023 and/or subsequent changes thereof.

Plan 2.1 is for those with the following qualifications:

- (1) Master's degree.
- (2) English proficiency test results at the level according to requirement set by Silpakorn University.
- (3) Possess the qualities stipulated under Article 7 of Silpakorn University Graduate Studies Regulations, 2023 and/or subsequent changes thereof.

Plan 2.2 is for those with the following qualifications:

- (1) Bachelor's degree with honors and minimum grade point average of 3.20, plus minimum of 4 years working experience in a field related to the program, ***or***
- (2) A student currently studying for the Master's degree in Architectural Heritage Management and Tourism or Architectural Heritage, Creative Industries, and Tourism Management at Silpakorn University, and has completed a minimum of 24 credits with a grade point average of not less than 3.50, is eligible to apply for a transfer to this plan at the discretion of the program coordinating committee provided that the Bachelor's degree attained was at the level of Very Good.
- (3) English proficiency test results at the level according to requirement set by Silpakorn University.

- (4) Possess the qualities stipulated under Article 7 of Silpakorn University Graduate Studies Regulations, 2023 and/or subsequent changes thereof.

Note: Doctoral degree applicants are required to have passed English proficiency test with results at the level equivalent to that of CEFR standards or according to requirement set by Silpakorn University before applying for the program. If not however, may under certain circumstances be permitted to take the admission exam on a provisional basis but must have achieved the required level before being able to register as a student.

Additional documents to be submitted together with the application:

1. Two letters of recommendation according to the form prescribed by the Faculty of Architecture for the Architectural Heritage, Creative Industries, and Tourism Management program.
2. A statement of applicant's objectives according to the form prescribed by the Faculty of Architecture for the Architectural Heritage, Creative Industries, and Tourism Management program.
