1.3 Plan 2.1 Graduates of Master's Degree in agricultural science, biological science, or related fields with an equivalent GPA of 3.00 or higher or with the decision and consent of the curricular academic committee.

1.4 Plan 2.2 Graduates with Bachelor's Degree in agricultural science, biological science, or related fields with excellent academic record and consent of the curricular academic committee.
