Eligibility to apply:

Plan A1 is for those with the following qualifications:

- (1) Bachelor's degree with minimum grade point average of 3.5 and at least 5 years working experience after graduation or have profound knowledge and extensive practical experience in a field related to the program (subject to approval by the program/admission committee).

- (2) English proficiency test results at the level according to requirement set by Silpakorn University.
- (3) Possess the qualities stipulated under Article 7 of Silpakorn University Graduate Studies Regulations, 2023 and/or subsequent changes thereof.

Plan A2 is for those with the following qualifications:

- (1) Bachelor's degree with minimum grade point average of 2.50
- (2) English proficiency test results at the level according to requirement set by Silpakorn University.
- (3) Possess the qualities stipulated under Article 7 of Silpakorn University Graduate Studies Regulations, 2023 and/or subsequent changes thereof.

Plan B is for those with the following qualifications:

- (1) Bachelor's degree with minimum grade point average of 2.50
- (2) English proficiency test results at the level according to requirement set by Silpakorn University.
- (3) Possess the qualities stipulated under Article 7 of Silpakorn University Graduate Studies Regulations, 2023 and/or subsequent changes thereof.
